Instructions on Dress code (For Male Participants)

1	Participants should not put on indulgent/unrestrained dress during
	class or occasion.
2	Participants should dress according to the guideline provided by
	course management team.
3	Participants must comb hair properly.
4	Unconventional hairstyles are strictly prohibited.
5	It is not allowed to use any kind of hair band.
6	Male participants must be clean shaved.
7	Beard must be properly trimmed.
8	Colour and design of attire must be as sober as it deemed to be
	official. Bright colour and any kind of lase is unacceptable.
9	Jeans pant, loose pant or collarless t-shirt is not accepted.
10	Only dark coloured (Black and Navy Blue) formal suit is allowed.
11	Wearing tie is mandatory during training period.
12	Shirt and trouser must not be too tight or too loose.
13	Shirt, pant or suit should not be too tight or too loose.
14	Colour of the socks must be consistent with the pant and shoe thus
	no portion of legs become visible.
15	Light perfume can be used.
16	Dress up must be neat and clean with required level of
	iron and starch.
17	Use of any jewellery is strictly prohibited. Attire, hair style and shoe
	must have the combined reflection that an officer should have.

Instructions on Dress code (For Female Participants)

Participants should not put on indulgent/unrestrained dress during class or occasion.
Participant must comb hair properly, preferably braided or tied with hair band.
Indecent jewellery must not be used.
Colour and design of attire (Sharee and Blouse) must be as sober as it deemed to be official. Bright colour and any kind of lase is unacceptable.
Participants should put on toe covered shoe. Slippers, sponge sandals or hawaiian slippers are not accepted.
Design and colour of shoe must be decent.
Jewellery must be decent. Heavy, unconventional, expensive and unrestrained jewelleries are not allowed.

All sessions	 Maintain colour code (Three colours - Green, Blue, Pink) sharee fixed by the academy Supplementary parts of dress must be consistent with sharee. Foot covered with black shoe. Salwar kamiz is not accepted.
